thinking period—so for every question, you only need one

- Contest:** There will be 3 preliminary rounds of 30 questions.
Ties will be broken with tie-breaker questions.
- The organization of the preliminary rounds will depend on the
total sign-ups, but it is expected that 12-15 teams will advance
to the final round which will consist of 40 questions.
- No scores will carry over. Top score in the finals will be the
Rotary Challenge winner and receive an appropriate prize.
