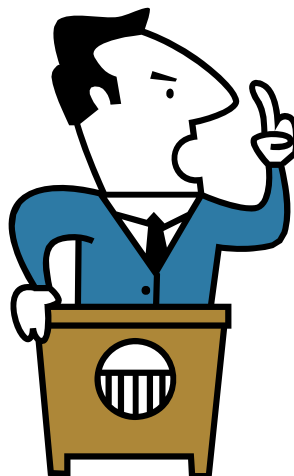
located in an outlying area park in a small

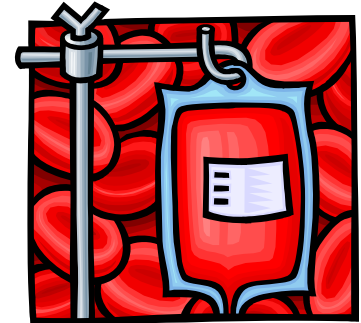
- ♦ What services does our school/ community need?

Sponsoring a Blood Drive at the High School that netted 56 pints



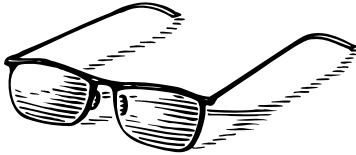
Modesto Christian Interact Club has done numerous projects recently, including:
