### **Rules of the Camp**

1. Interactors are responsible for clearing their own setting, all common items on their tables, and wiping their table.
2. Cups, dishes, and flatware are not to be removed from the dining hall.
3. **Food is not allowed in cabins** and rooms due to health regulations, insects and occasional wild animals (deer, raccoons, skunks).
4. No gum or sunflower seeds at the camp.
5. No smoking by Interactors at any time and by adults only in the designated area of the parking lot. No illegal drugs, alcohol or immodest/inappropriate dress.
6. Interactors must stay within camp boundaries that are marked. Stay on roads and trails.
7. Quiet Time: 10:00pm to 7:00am. On Saturday night, there will be a time designated when all Interactors will need to stay in their cabins. After that time, no Interactors shall be out of their cabin (even just to talk).
