POLIO PLUS QUICK FACTS

- The number of cases of polio has
declined by 99 percent since
1988.
- A child can be protected against
polio for as little as US\$0.50
worth of vaccine.
- Today, thanks to the polio
eradication initiative, more than
four million children who might
have been polio victims are
walking and playing normally.
More than 500,000 cases of polio
are now prevented each year
- At the Rotary convention in San
Antonio, UNICEF Executive
Director Carol Bellamy made the
welcome announcement that all
proceeds of the "Trick-or-Treat
for UNICEF" campaign for this year
and next will go to polio
eradication.
