Sandy and I are looking forward to seeing everybody at the District Conference at the beautiful Tenaya Lodge at Yosemite.

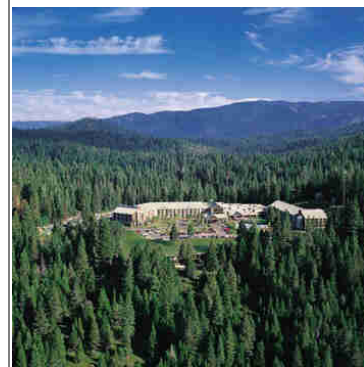
