

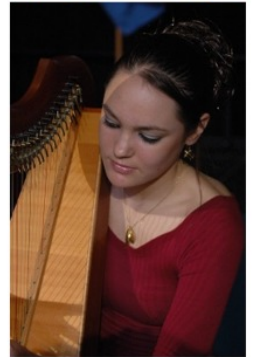


## ROTARY PRIDE IN DISTRICT 5220
