

## **SAMPLE: RI/CLUB ATTENDANCE REQUIREMENTS**

As a prospective member of Rotary, attendance is a very important area of consideration. The \_\_\_\_\_ Rotary Club feels so strongly about attendance, that it must be reviewed and discussed in some detail at this time.

- 1. Rotary International has established that a member must maintain 60% attendance at all times to be in good standing.**
- 2. The \_\_\_\_\_ Rotary Club accepts this minimum level of attendance, but would hope a member would strive for 80-85% attendance at all times.**
- 3. Attendance at 100% is wonderful, but is not necessary. It would be preferable to see a member support some of the many activities the Club is involved in throughout the year.**
- 4. MAKEUPS: Rotary has provided members the opportunity to makeup meetings at another Club and receive credit. There are five other Clubs in Stockton: three are luncheon Clubs and two are Clubs that meet for breakfast. Lodi, Manteca, Tracy, Escalon all have Rotary Clubs. (Include: day; time; meeting location; location address; and telephone number, if appropriate.) If you are going to be out of the area and wish to makeup, the Club Secretary has a directory of "ALL" Rotary clubs throughout the world--approx. 29,000--or use the Rotary Website--<http://www.rotary.org>. (The financial cost for meetings missed, without making up, is \$10 per missed meeting.)**
- 5. TIME FRAME FOR MAKEUPS: A member can makeup two weeks prior to the regular meetings date and two weeks after the regular meeting date that is missed. Rotarians can also receive makeup credit by attending District Conference, District Assembly, District Safari, Rotary International Convention if it falls within the time frame for a makeup. The \_\_\_\_\_ Rotary Club members can also attend the monthly Board meeting, the Interact Club and the Youthact Club to receive makeup credit.**

**Failure to maintain satisfactory attendance can result in automatic termination by the Board of Directors of the \_\_\_\_\_ Rotary Club. If you have any questions, either consult with your sponsor or contact the Club Secretary.**
